WINTER HAVEN – Winter Haven Police have arrested four people in the armed robbery and car-jacking of a 43-year old man.

On Sept. 17, 2011 the victim met Shirien Keverenge (B/F, 6-29-93, 54 Poe Dr., Winter Haven) and Shanyce Black (B/F, 11-18-94, 693 Ave. G, SE, Winter Haven) in the area of Crispers restaurant in Winter Haven. The victim gave them his phone number and told the females to call him later. After receiving several calls from the females, he decided to meet them at a coin laundry in the 500 block of Ave. J, SE. Keverenge and Black asked the victim to buy them some items from the Circle K and while the he was inside the store making the purchases, they discussed a plan to rob him.

Keverenge and Black contacted Qornelious Campbell (B/M, 3-23-93, 2401 2nd St, NW, Winter Haven) and Darrell Miller (B/M, 8-31-93, 127 Ave. V, NW, Winter Haven) via text message and all agreed the females would lure the victim to Sportsman Park for the robbery.

At approximately 10:30 p.m., they arrived at the park where Campbell and Miller approached the victim (Campbell had a gun) and demanded money. The two males beat the victim until he was unconscious. When he woke up, his car, gold necklace, wallet and cell phone was missing. When the victim reported the crime, police were able to locate his vehicle with Keverenge and Black inside. Campbell and Miller were also identified and located. Officers found a .22 caliber revolver inside Campbell's residence next to his Florida ID card and the victim's chain was also located inside a pair of Campbell's shorts.

All four suspects were arrested for Armed Carjacking and Conspiracy to

Commit Armed Robbery. Miller and Campbell were also charged with Violation of Probation.
