WINTER HAVEN – A warrant has been obtained for the arrest of Sean Paul Webster, a violent felon who robbed a man in his Winter Haven home and pointed a sawed-off shotgun in the face of the victim. Charges include Armed Robbery with Firearm, Armed Burglary with Assault, three counts of False Imprisonment, two counts of Aggravated Battery and Possession of Firearm by Convicted Felon.

Webster, who police consider armed and extremely dangerous, has a “Fighting Irish” tattoo on the right side of his neck.

On 1-13-14 at approximately 11:45 a.m., 19 year-old Nathaniel Smith was awakened by the sound of someone coming into his residence, located at 830 Ave. N, SW, Winter Haven. When Smith opened his eyes he saw Sean Webster (W/M, DOB 3-1-72, 2316 Azalea Ct., Lakeland FL) standing over him with the weapon pointed at his face. Smith’s girlfriend, 18 year-old Breanna Hause, was also in the room and heard Webster enter the room. Webster threatened to shoot Smith saying, “This is real,” and demanded money.

Webster ordered both Smith and Hause out of the room and demanded that Smith put his two dogs away or he (Webster) would shoot them. Webster escorted both Smith and Hause outside to ensure the dogs were secured. Webster walked the pair back into the house continuing to tell them he was going to shoot them both. As Smith and Hause sat on the floor, Webster kicked Smith in the mouth and started ransacking the room looking for more money. Webster continued to move the pair at gunpoint to other areas of the house demanding money.

Smith’s brother, 22 year-old Bradley Dugan, came to the residence and started to enter through the back door. When Webster saw Dugan, he grabbed him by the collar and hit him on the side of the head with the shotgun barrel, forcing him at gunpoint into the residence. Webster then picked up a

computer and fled the residence in a 2000 red Pontiac Sunfire, which was later recovered by police in Lakeland.
